Minutes of **COPLEY TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEE SPECIAL MEETING** Meeting

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Trustee Helen Humphrys convened the Special Meeting of the Copley Township Board of Trustees at 10:00 a.m. on Wednesday, January 17, 2018.

MEMBERS PRESENT: Trustee Humphrys, Trustee Koellner, Administrator Janice Marshall, Service Director Mark Mitchell, CED Director Matt Springer, and Joe Paradise of the Summit County Engineer's Office. Trustee Scott Dressler was absent from the meeting.

The purpose of the meeting was to meet with the Summit County Engineer's office to receive updates on road projects. Joe Paradise listed the following:


- Cleveland Massillon Repaving: Repaving road from Norton line to Copley Circle – will be cutting rock on south side of Barberton Reservoir about 6 feet back to be able to widen roadway; plan to install four feet wide paved shoulders.
- Fairlawn Project – 20% of the project is in Copley Township which is why the county is participating; they are not contributing to the roundabout.
- Turn lanes at Ridgewood Road/Cleveland Massillon: the construction dollars have been earmarked for 2023-2024 but there is no money for the design of the project. Engineer's Office indicated the project could be moved up in the timeline if the Township would consider contributing the cost of design in the amount of \$100,000.00 – could move the project up to 2020.
- The project at Copley Road and Cleveland Massillon is slotted to begin in the summer of 2019. Joe Paradise is helping to contact the state to coordinate the work with the Bicentennial Celebration
- Wright Rd. bridge – have contracted with MS Consultants for the design of the bridge replacement project; construction to begin 2019.

There were concerns raised about road closures during the Copley Bicentennial and notifying property owners of the changes that will be happening.


ADJOURNMENT
