- Technology will be distributed at the Summit County Job and Family Service Parking lot located at the Pry Building 1180 S. Main Street Akron, Ohio 44301. You MUST pre-register and pre-pay. You will be given a specific time to arrive. Walk in appointments will not be available.
- Pre-Register and pre-pay to reserve your technology. Financial aid available for individuals who cannot afford package costs. Supported by: Summit County Executive, Ilene Shapiro and Community Development Block Grant Fund. \*Financial aid is on a first come first serve basis and not available for all school districts
