Cemetery Regulations

1.
 - A. Lots will be sold only at a time of need. No lots will be reserved.
 - B. Only one, two, or three grave lots will be sold depending on need at the time of sale.
 - C. Lots will be sold by numeric order according to Section. No selection of gravesite.
2.
 - A. Lot fees must be paid at the time of purchase.
 - B. A lot may be purchased only by current Copley Township residents or past residents who had resided in the Township for a minimum of ten (10) years.
3.
 - A. Funerals will be held Monday through Saturday after 9 a.m. Any funeral after 2:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and on Saturday will incur an extra charge. No funerals are permitted on Sunday or Holidays.
 - B. All funerals, upon reaching the Cemetery, shall be under the charge of the Sexton or his assistants.
4. All burials in the Veterans Memorial Section must go through the American Legion Post #473. Veteran marker forms are the responsibility of the family. Copley Township will install the marker.
5. Copley Township reserves the right to move any headstone to allow the digging of any grave in the vicinity.
6. All caskets shall be placed in a steel or concrete vault.
7. Caskets will be lowered into graves fifteen (15) minutes after the conclusion of the burial ceremonies.
8. Headstone foundations are to be installed by Copley Township only. Foundations are to be no larger than fifty-four inches (54") long by fourteen inches (14") wide. Foundations will be installed twice per year; once in May before Memorial Day and once in November before Veterans Day.
9.
 - A. Plantings of all dwarf trees, shrubs, etc. are to be in line with the headstone, not to exceed the width of the grave lot, as are urns and vases.
 - B. Annual plants may be placed within 12" of the front and back of the headstone. No plantings are allowed to exceed the width of the grave lot.
 - C. Copley Township reserves the right to trim all shrubs and bushes, and to remove those that become a liability or a nuisance.
 - D. All pots, vases, and urns will be emptied by Copley Township after the first killing frost. Copley Township will not be responsible for any damage which may occur.
 - E. All live cut flowers and/or live grave decorations not planted must be removed within two (2) weeks of placement. Winter holiday decorations must be removed by February 1st.
10. Copley Township reserves the right of maintenance to keep the cemetery grounds clean. The Township will remove any or all plantings that appear abandoned or unsightly.
